SPECIALTY AREA REQUIREMENTS

A student pursuing this major will consult with a designated advisor in the Center for Adult and Professional Studies, to design a major program of study that meets the requirements listed below. The completed program proposal will be submitted to the Christian Studies Committee (SOR Dean and CAPS Director) for review and final approval. The student will be admitted to the major after the proposal has been approved.

The specialty area must meet the following criteria:

- The major must include a minimum of 48 hours.
The student must select courses from four separate disciplines chosen from the list below.
A minimum of twelve credit hours must be taken from each of the four selected disciplines.
At least 24 hours of the major must be in upper division (300 and 400 level) courses.
To graduate a Minimum major GPA of 2.0 is required.
A minimum of 120 hours are required for graduation. The major is only 48 hours therefore; the student must take enough general electives to fill the remaining hours required for graduation.
Courses taken to meet general education core or religion core requirements will not count toward the major.

The student may choose courses from any four of the following disciplines:

- Bible
Christian Education
Christian Leadership
Intercultural Studies
Pastoral Ministry
Theology
